A Moment of Renewal: Highlights from the 2025 AGM

On 15 March 2025, under the warmth of a late afternoon sun at E131, neighbours gathered for the Annual General Meeting (AGM)—a key moment of reflection, planning, and renewal for our Association. With 40 members present or represented out of 58, the quorum was met, and the meeting was officially opened by outgoing President, Mr. Soopramanien Comaren. His address captured the spirit of community-led progress, sharing two years of effort: from landscaping and lighting improvements to active engagements with authorities and neighbourhood events.

The Treasurer's financial overview highlighted a healthy profit of MUR 288,562.50 for 2024, with carefully planned budgets for 2025 and 2026 that focus on core needs like cleaning, landscaping, and dog sterilization. The community then unanimously voted in the new Management Committee for the 2025–2026 term.

The AGM closed with a renewed sense of purpose and unity—laying the groundwork for an even more vibrant Morcellement Aurea.

Road to Restoration: Sewer Works Underway on Iremia/Aurea Road

We're pleased to update you on the ongoing trenching works along Iremia/Aurea Road. Earlier this month, members of the Committee met with the site supervisor overseeing the sewer line project.

The contractor has confirmed that the estimated timeline for completion is around three months, with work expected to finish by mid-July 2025.

Once the sewer line is in place, a temporary tarring will be applied to ensure safe passage. Following that, the contractor will permanently resurface the full lane where the trenching was done — restoring the road to its original condition. We'll continue to monitor progress and keep you informed. Thank you for your patience and understanding as these essential upgrades move forward.
